Adult Roles (18+)

Miss Trunchbull (Open to all genders –Baritone/Tenor)

-A Domineering, larger-than-life-villain. Requires strong comedic timing, physicality, and singing.

Miss Honey (Female –Soprano/Mezzo)

-A soft and nurturing teacher with warmth and vulnerability. Requires moderate singing abilities countered with strong acting.

Mr. Wormwood (Male –Tenor/Baritone)

-Matilda's loud, dim-witted father. A strong comedic role with mild to moderate physicality.

Mrs. Wormwood (Female –Mezzo/Soprano)

-Matilda's mother. Comedic role with big and bold dance numbers, moderate physicality required.

Mrs. Phelps (Female –Mezzo/Soprano)

-Matilda's warm and kindhearted librarian. A nurturing presence with strong acting and mild to moderate vocals.

The Escapologist (Male –Baritone/Tenor)

-A mysterious figure in Matilda's imagination. Strong vocals preferred, doubles in ensemble.

The Acrobat (Female –Mezzo/Soprano)

-An ethereal figure from Matilda's imagination. Requires movement and mild to moderate vocals.

Rudolpho (Male –Tenor/Baritone)

-Mrs. Wormwood's flamboyant dance partner. Comedic flair and strong dance abilities.

Doctor (Any gender –Tenor/Baritone/Mezzo)

Comedic cameo singing role required

Youth Roles (Ages 11-16)

Matilda Wormwood (Female –Mezzo/Soprano)

A Brilliant and imaginative young girl. Requires strong acting and singing.

Bruce Bogtrotter (Any gender –Tenor)

A timid but brave classmate who stands up to Miss Trunchbull. Requires strong vocals and mild/moderate physicality.

Lavender (Female –Mezzo)

Matilda's mischievous and playful best friend.

Michael Wormwood (Male –Baritone)

Matilda's dull, TV-obsessed older brother. Requires dry humor.

Classmates (Male & Female –All Voice Types)

Amanda, Nigel, Eric, Alice, Hortensia, and Tommy: All very lively and full of energy with unique personalities.

Ensemble (Ages 15+, All Voice Types)

Parents, teachers, and "big kids" at school. Seeking strong singers, dancers, and character actors.
